Resolutions

Resolution No. 85 authorizing the Town Board of the Town of Colonie to certify the list of active volunteer firefighters from the S.W. Pitts Hose Company of Latham NY, Maplewood Volunteer Fire Department, Shaker Road-Loudonville Fire Department, and Fuller Road Fire Department, submitted and certified under oath by said Fire Department, identifying those current members who have at least two (2) years of active volunteer service seeking to receive a real property tax exemption pursuant to Chapter 171 of the Code of the Town of Colonie.
