Final Resolution, Order and Determination pursuant to Article 12A of the New York State Town Law in relation to the establishment of Extension No. 170 to the Latham Water District in the Town of Colonie, County of Albany, State of New York.

WHEREAS, the Latham Water District has heretofore been created by the Town Board of the Town of Colonie, Albany County, New York; and

WHEREAS, the Latham Water District of the Town of Colonie proposes to extend the limits of the existing water district boundary; and

WHEREAS, a report, map, plan and estimate of cost relating to Extension No. 170 to the Latham Water District has been prepared by C.T. Male Associates, engineers duly licensed by the State of New York, and has been filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Colonie in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Town Law and is available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, said extension shall include eight (8) separate areas that are located throughout the Town of Colonie and contiguous to the existing Water District which includes two (2) new users and six (6) areas which are existing users outside the current District boundaries that are adjacent to existing extensions; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries and descriptions of such areas are described in detail in the aforementioned engineer's report on file with the Town Clerk's Office of the Town of Colonie; and

WHEREAS, the proposed extension is to include the aforementioned areas in the Latham Water District so that all property served can be assessed for their proper share of the cost of operating the District; and

WHEREAS, requisite permits and approvals have been obtained from New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and New York State Health Department, as indicated in the aforementioned engineer's report; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount to be expended for said Extension is Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,900.00) to be paid for by excess water rents of the District; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution was duly adopted by said Board on the 3rd day of February, 2022, pursuant to paragraph (b) of §8 of said Chapter 950 of the Laws of 1972 calling for a public hearing on said map, plan and estimate of cost to be held at the Town Hall, Latham, New York on the 10th day of March, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. Local Time; and

WHEREAS, notice of such public hearing was duly published and posted in the manner and within the time provided by Chapter 950 of the Laws of 1972; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held at the time and place aforesaid at which time all persons interested in the subject matter thereof were duly heard; and

WHEREAS, said Board duly considered the evidence given at the said public hearing, and on the 10th day of March, 2022 said Board approves the establishment of Extension No. 170 to the Latham Water District subject to Permissive Referendum and makes the following determinations:

- a) That the notice of hearing was published and posted as required by law, and is otherwise sufficient;
- b) That all property and property owners within the proposed extension area are benefitted thereby;
- c) That all the property and property owners benefitted are included within the limits of the proposed extension;
- d) That it is in the public interest to establish the water district extension;

WHEREAS, no petition for permissive referendum was filed; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the State Comptroller is not required pursuant to the provisions of sec. 209(f) of the Town Law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, RESOLVED, AND DETERMINED, by the Town Board of the Town of Colonie, Albany County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Upon the evidence given at the aforesaid public hearing, it is hereby determined that the property owners within the proposed improvement area are benefitted thereby

and that said benefited property and property owners are included within the limits of the proposed improvement area.

Section 2. Upon the evidence given at the aforesaid public hearing, it is hereby found and determined that it is in the public interest to construct the aforesaid improvements at the maximum amount to be expended for the aforementioned improvements is Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,900.00) to be paid for by excess water rents of the District; and

ORDERED, RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that the Town Clerk is directed to cause a certified copy of this Order, Resolution and Determination to be recorded in the Office of Clerk of the County of Albany within ten days (10) after the adoption thereof.

and gate fees at the Colonie Mohawk River Park; with such discounts mirroring those provided to Colonie Senior Citizens at such facilities; and

BE IT RESOLVED that “eligible volunteers” are defined as those Town of Colonie residents who are active and good standing members, including those recognized as life members, of Town of Colonie fire departments; and

BE IT RESOLVED that to access the discount at the time it is to be applied, “eligible volunteers” shall present a current Town of Colonie fire department accountability card, or such department’s official annual identification document.
