WHEREAS, the Town of Colonie Emergency Medical Services Department is an authorized American Heart Association Training Center and provides AHA course training in the Town of Colonie; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Colonie will give the City of Albany, Albany County Sheriff's Office, the Airport Authority, Infinity Med Solutions, Watervliet Arsenal, Shaker Road Fire Department, New York State Police and Valatie Rescue Squad the authorization to conduct AHA training as a satellite program for the public under the Town of Colonie Training Center program;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisor be, and hereby is, authorized to execute Agreements between the Town of Colonie and the City of Albany, Albany County Sheriff's Office, the Airport Authority, Infinity Med Solutions, Watervliet Arsenal, Shaker Road Fire Department, New York State Police and Valatie Rescue Squad to conduct AHA training as a satellite program for the public under the Town of Colonie EMS Training Center program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such Agreements are subject to the review and approval of the Town Attorney's Office.
