Resolution pursuant to §202 of the New York State Town Law Approving the Annual Estimate of Expense of Improvements and Benefit Assessment Roll for the Town of Colonie Sewer Improvement Area.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Colonie has heretofore dissolved certain sewer districts within the Town of Colonie, County of Albany, State of New York, and formed the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area; and

WHEREAS, the expense of constructing sewers, sewage disposal plants and drainage systems, and constructing lateral sewers within the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area, is to be borne by local assessment upon the several lots and parcels of land within said area in the manner provided by Chapter 950 of the Laws of 1973, and §202 of the Town Law; and

WHEREAS, the annual estimate of expense of improvements, along with the Assessment Roll for said Sewer Improvement Area, has been prepared and describes each lot or parcel of land contained within said Sewer Improvement Area and shows the names of the reputed owner or owners thereof and the aggregate amount of assessment to be levied upon each such lot or parcel of land; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid estimates and Assessment Roll are available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Colonie, County of Albany, State of New York and on the Town’s website;

WHEREAS, a Resolution was duly adopted by said Board on the 15th day of October 2025, pursuant to the New York State Town Law calling for a public hearing on said assessment rolls to be held at the Town Hall, Latham, New York on the 6th day of November 2025, at 6:30 p.m. Local Time; and

WHEREAS, notice of such public hearing was duly published and posted in the manner and within the time provided by Chapter 950 of the Laws of 1972; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held at the time and place aforesaid at which time all persons interested in the subject matter thereof were duly heard; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Colonie, Albany County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Upon the evidence given at the aforesaid public hearing, it is hereby determined that the properties as described in aforementioned assessment rolls are benefited by the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area and that said benefited property and property owners are included within the limits of said improvement area.

Section 2. That said benefit assessment roll of the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area as above for the payment of the expense of construction and improvements for the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area pursuant to Section 202 of the New York State Town Law be and is hereby approved.

Section 3. That the Town Clerk is instructed to annex to said benefit assessment roll a warrant which shall be signed by the Supervisor and countersigned by the Town Clerk commanding the Town Tax Collector to collect from the several persons named in said assessment roll the sum or sums opposite their respective names and to pay the same to the Supervisor of the Town.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
